5. What did the conductor tell the audience?

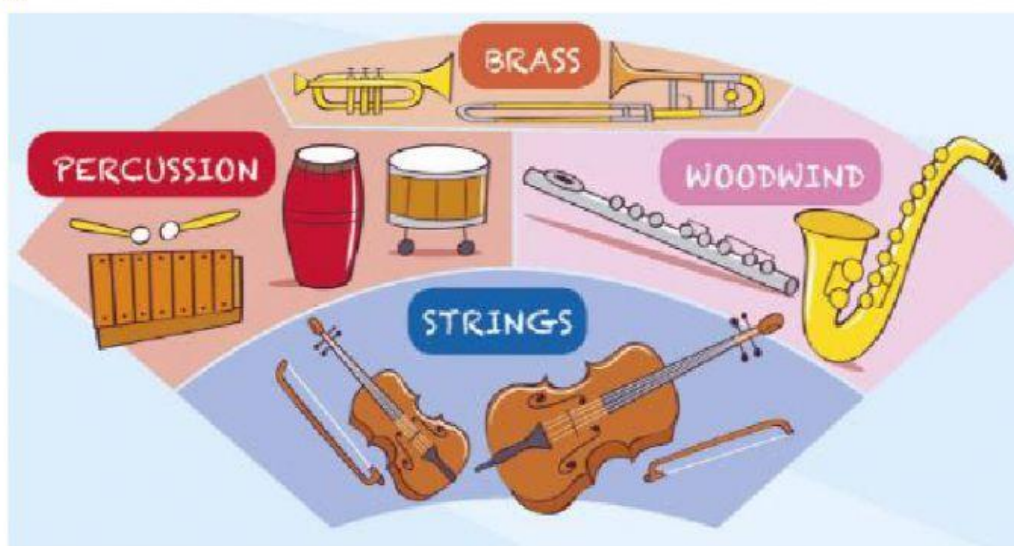


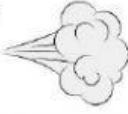
