### Column addition - Adding 3 addends

1. Dad has 235 blue t-shirts, 187 black t-shirts, and 421 white t-shirts. How many t-shirts does dad have in all?
2. In his toy box, Tom has 536 red cars, 384 green cars, and 937 blue cars. How many cars are in Tom's toy box?
3. At the pet shop, I saw 784 kittens, 469 puppies, and 853 hamsters. How many pets did I see?
4. At the toy store, Jill saw 186 teddy bears, 549 panda bears, and 768 polar bears. How many bears did Jill see?
5. Dad bought 923 bananas, 562 apples, and 297 apricots. How many pieces of fruit did dad buy?
6. On her birthday Leah ate 356 pieces of chocolate in the morning, 107 pieces in the afternoon, and 243 pieces after dinner. How many pieces of chocolate did Leah eat on her birthday?
7. At the beach Pam counted 429 crabs in a rock pool. 854 crabs on the sand, and 199 crabs on a rock. How many crabs did Pam count in all?
8. At the park, I saw 958 dogs barking at a squirrel. 783 eating bones, and 521 chasing a ball. How many dogs did I see at the park?
9. On a rainy day Bob saw 189 red umbrellas, 596 blue umbrellas, and 627 black umbrellas. How many umbrellas did Bob see?
10. To put his hand into the coin jar and pulled out 859 dimes, 627 nickels, and 717 pennies. How many coins did Tom pull out of the jar?
