We use "have to" to talk about something that we need to do.

⊕ I have to go to school tomorrow. / She **has** to clean her room.

⊖ He **doesn't** have to write the report. / We **don't** have to go for practice today.

⊕ Q: Does he **have** to wake up at 6:00 a.m.? / Do they **have** to wake up at 6:00 a.m.?  
A: Yes, he **has** to. / No, they **don't** have to.
