<input type="checkbox"/> Is there a TV? <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Yes, there is .	Are there any pictures? Yes, there are .
<input type="checkbox"/> Is there a bath? <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> No, there isn't .	Are there any towels? No, there aren't .
