

## EXISTENCE: There is / there are

Look at the chart and complete the rules:

Singular	Plural
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>+</b> <b>There's</b> a TV in the room. ( <i>there's = there is</i> ) <b>There's</b> a shower.	<b>There are</b> two beds in the room. <b>There are</b> <b>some</b> pictures.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>-</b> <b>There isn't</b> a phone. <b>There isn't</b> a bath.	<b>There aren't</b> <b>any</b> towels. <b>There aren't</b> <b>any</b> books.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>?</b> <b>Is there</b> a TV? <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> <b>Yes, there is.</b>	<b>Are there</b> <b>any</b> pictures? <b>Yes, there are.</b>
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>?</b> <b>Is there</b> a bath? <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> <b>No, there isn't.</b>	<b>Are there</b> <b>any</b> towels? <b>No, there aren't.</b>

### RULES:

1. Use *There is* and *There are* to talk about Routine / Abilities / Existence.
2. For the negative, add the word NOT. The abbreviated negative forms are \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.
3. For the questions write \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ first.
