- 'What **were** you **doing** at 9?' 'I **was studying**.'
- When I saw them yesterday, they **were arguing**.

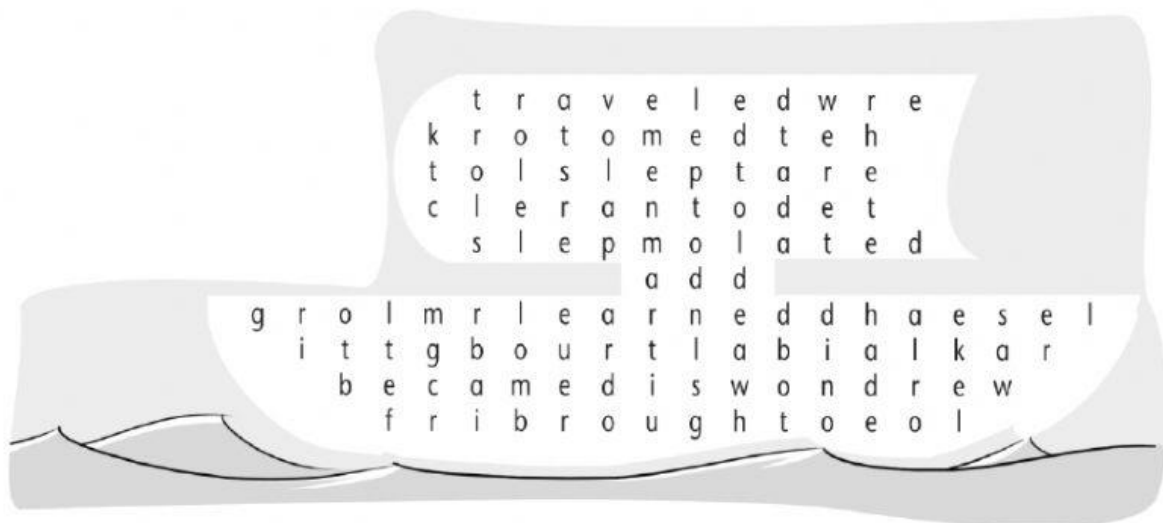
