Vowel	☐	☐ the way in which a syllable in a word is given more force.
Word Family	☐	☐ a group of words that have the same basic form.
Weak form	☐	☐ a unit of sound within a word.
Suffix	☐	☐ is an affix place before the stem of a word.
Prefix	☐	☐ a sound that involves two vowels joined together.
Consonant	☐	☐ a letter or group of letters that can be added to the end of a word to change its meaning.
Word Stress	☐	☐ A speech sound made by blockig or partly blocking the air used to make the sound.
Syllable	☐	☐ a speech sound made without blocking the air used to produce the sound.
Diphthong	☐	☐ when a word changes its pronunciation according to whether it is stressed or not. (It is the unstressed version)
