Mediterranean... The Best Weather!

There are some coastal regions on **earth** that are near the Mediterranean sea. The weather is mild and there are only two seasons: summer and winter. This **climate** is called Mediterranean.



It is usually warm, hot, and dry when it is summer. The winter **season** is **mild** or cool and it usually rains.

› Landscape: The Mediterranean landscape has rivers with an irregular flow, and they carry very little water.

The vegetation is made up of trees such as holm oaks and pine trees. Grape vines, fig trees, olive trees, and citrus trees also grow. There are also shrubs and aromatic plants such as lavender and rosemary.

› Human Impact: The human impact on the Mediterranean landscape is noticeable! Many forests are cut down to **plant** wheat, olive trees, and create pasture for livestock. Many inland and coastal **areas** are transformed to build hotels and resorts for tourism.

How Many Oceans Are There?

Oceans and Continents

Most of the earth is **covered** by water. About 71% of earth's surface is under the oceans and seas. The dry land of the continents makes up 29% of the earth's surface.

The continents are very **large** land masses, **surrounded** by oceans and seas. The seven continents are Asia, South America, North America, Africa, Europe, Antarctica, and Australia.

The five oceans are connected to each other, and they are:

- › Pacific Ocean: It is the largest and **deepest** ocean.
- › Atlantic Ocean: It is the second largest ocean.
- › Indian Ocean: It has no natural **border** separating it from the Atlantic.
- › Southern Ocean: It is almost **frozen** for most of the year.
- › Arctic Ocean: It is the smallest ocean. It is also frozen.

Oceanic Landscapes

Oceanic landscapes are usually very green. Their vegetation is abundant because of **regular rainfall**. There are various types of oceanic landscapes:

- › There are deciduous trees, such as oaks and beeches, which lose their leaves in fall.
- › There are moors in areas where the soil is poor. **Bushes** and short **grasses** grow in the moors.
- › There are meadows where grass grows, which is normally used as pasture for animals.

The Oceanic Climate

Also known as the **maritime** climate, it is mainly found in **coastal** regions in temperate zones:

- › Temperatures are mild all year round because the ocean is not far away.
- › Precipitation is heavy and regular. It rains in all seasons. Consequently, rivers always have an abundant, regular flow.
