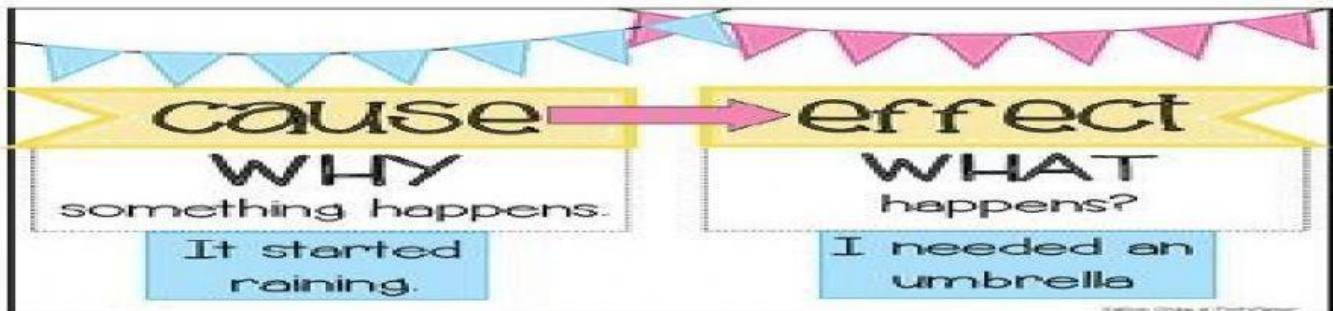


Target Skill

Cause and Effect

The cause is why something happens in the story.

The effect is what happens in the story as a result of the cause. Remember that what happens first is the cause and what happens next is the effect.
