

Key Vocabulary

You will find lots of new words throughout the activities. When you don't know the meaning of a word, you can either ask for its meaning "What does X mean?" or check it up in a [dictionary](#). Let's see how dictionaries work.

DICTIONARIES

Dictionaries are really helpful when learning a language, especially if it is a foreign language.

Let us guess how they can help us, place the numbers:

1. If the word has different meanings, it tells you the specific meaning for a "context".
2. It tells you its meaning or translation.
3. It tells you what part of speech the word is: noun, verb, adjective, adverb, pronoun, article, preposition, conjunction or interjection.
4. You can find a synonym here to avoid word repetition.
5. You can see the word in context.
6. You can see which words often go together with this word.
7. You learn how to pronounce the word.
