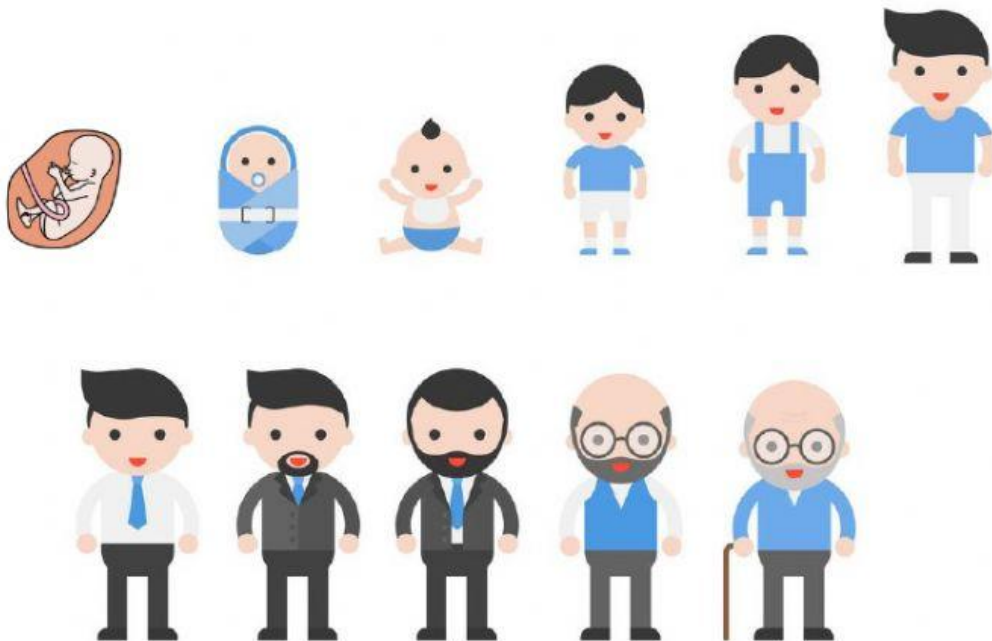


# HUMAN LIFE CYCLE
