Pear leaf tea is a delicious Bahamian drink that is easy to make. Ask an adult to help you use the stove. You will need about 12 pear leaves, a medium sized pot, four cups of water, sugar, cream and a cup. **First**, wash your pear leaves in clear water. **Then** put them in the pot of water, cover the pot, place it on the stove and let it boil for about seven to ten minutes. **Next**, remove the leaves from the pot and carefully pour some of the liquid into the cup. **Finally**, add as much sugar and cream as you wish to add taste to your tea.
