

Reported Speech

Finish the sentences using Reported speech.

To transform a sentence in the present form, for example:

Mark: I eat cereal every morning.

First, we have to start with the subject and make clear that we are reporting the sentence, by adding the "said":

Mark said ...

Then, we proceed to transform the sentence to the past form, since the sentence was uttered somewhere before:

Mark said he ate cereal every morning.
