USE	STRUCTURE	EXAMPLES		
- Predictions - Something already planned. - Intentions	am / is / are + going to + verb	- I am going to eat. - He is going to eat. - I'm gonna eat. - She's gonna eat.	- I am not going to eat. - He is not going to eat. - I'm not going to eat. - She's not going to eat.	- Am I going to eat? - Is he going to eat? - Are we going to eat?
