
VERTEBRATE or INVERTEBRATE

Vertebrates have a backbone, are usually larger and faster than invertebrates, have a developed brain (in a skull), and have a complex nervous system.



Invertebrates do not have a backbone, are usually small and slowmoving, do not have a well developed brain, and have a simple nervous system.
