(of the main verb)

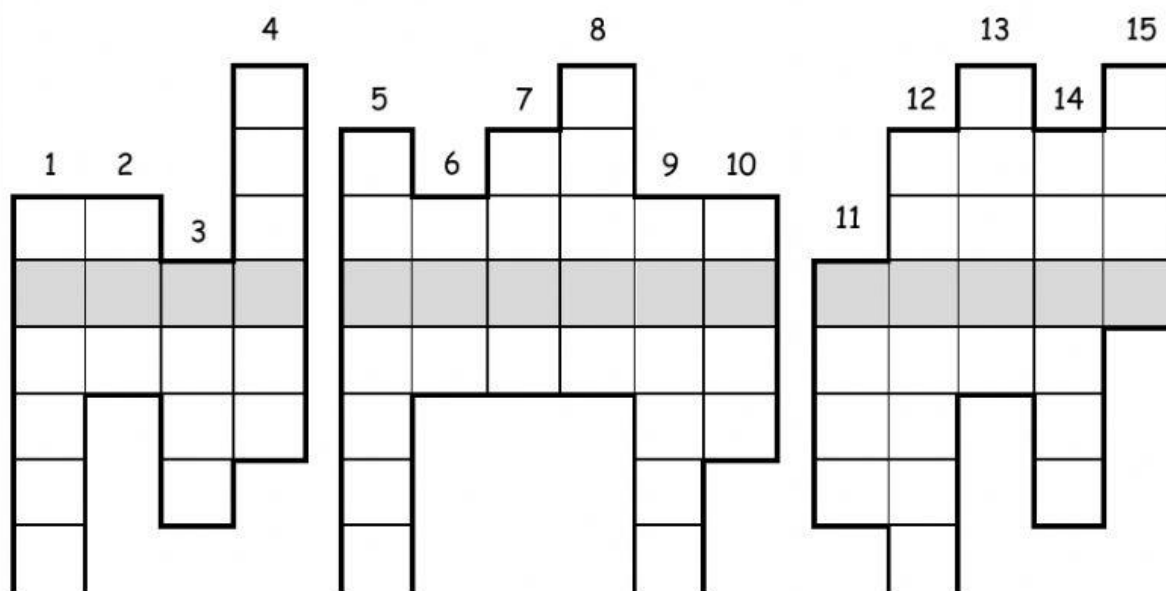
