2. Simplify the following:

a. $\frac{x}{2} + \frac{3x}{5}$

b. $\frac{7x}{4} - \frac{5x}{6}$

c. $\frac{2}{3x} - \frac{5}{4x}$

d. $\frac{3x-4}{5} + \frac{5x+1}{4}$

e. $\frac{7m-2}{3} - \frac{2m+3}{2}$
