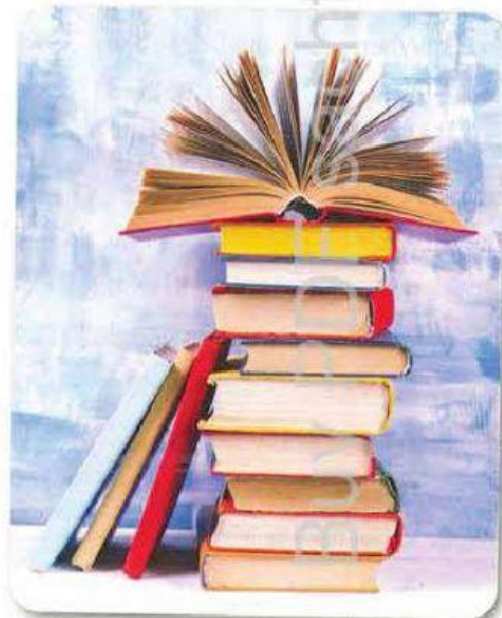

 - Does he like **indoor activities**? - No, he doesn't. He likes **outdoor activities**.

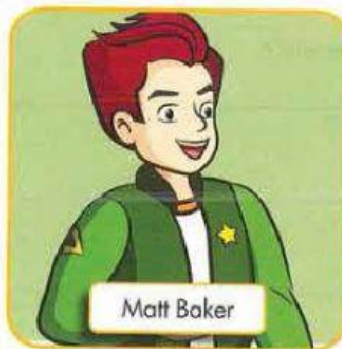

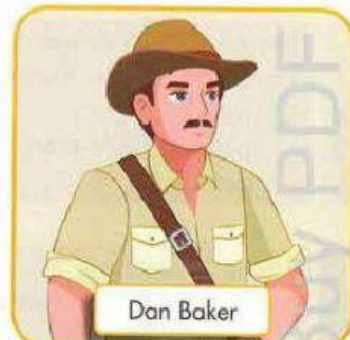
