Who	Which
- used for people (digunakan untuk ORANG) - before a verb (SEBELUM kata kerja) The woman called yesterday. She wants to buy the house.  The woman <u>who</u> called yesterday wants to buy the house.	used for things and animals (digunakan untuk BENDA dan HAIWAN) This is the car. Alex wants to buy the car.  This is the car <u>which</u> Alex wants to buy
