


Reteach: The Skeletal System

Part 1

Match the parts of the skeletal system with their definition.

Tendon	rubber-like padding that covers and protects the ends of long bones at the joints
Cartilage	Point where 2 bones meet
Ligament	Connective tissue that connects bone to bone
Joint	Connective tissue that connects muscle to bone
Bone	A part of the skeletal system that protects the various organs of the body, produces red and white blood cells, stores minerals, provides structure and support for the body, and enables mobility
Bone Marrow	Inside part of a bone that produces red blood cells
