take only **-st**: large → The largest

• One syllable adjectives ending in  
consonant, vowel, consonant  
**double the consonant** and take **-est**  
hot → The hottest big → The biggest

• Two syllable adjectives ending in **-y**  
**y** changes to **i** and take **-est**  
noisy → The noisiest heavy → The heaviest

## short adjectives

The + **est**  
tall → The tallest

## irregular adjectives

Good → The best

Bad → The worst

Far → The farthest/ furthest

## long adjectives

The most  
difficult → The most difficult

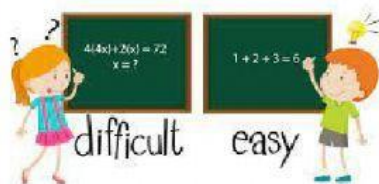

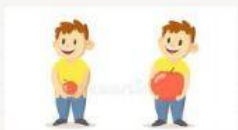
