Noncommunicable Diseases		a. The removal of a sample tissue from a person for examination.
Chronic Diseases		b. Characteristics or behaviors that increase the likelihood of developing a medical disorder or disease.
Degenerative Diseases		c. Radioactive therapy to kill cancer cells.
Congenital Disorders		d. A disease that cannot be spread from person to person.
Heredity		e. A cancer-causing substance.
Cancer		f. The spread of cancer from where it first develops.
Tumor		g. Non-cancerous
Benign		h. All disorders that are present when the baby is born.
Malignant		i. People whose cells contain oncogenes may develop certain forms of cancer.
Risk Factors		j. A disease characterized by the rapid and uncontrolled growth of abnormal cells.
Carcinogens		k. Disease lasts for more than three months.
Biopsy		l. A mass of abnormal cells.
Radiation Therapy		m. Tumors that are cancerous.
Metastasis		n. A disease that causes a breakdown of the body cells, tissues, and organs as it progresses.
