### (NOT) AS + ADJECTIVE + AS

✓ We use (not) as + adjective/adverb + as to make comparisons when the things we are comparing are equal in some way.

*The world's biggest bull is as big as a small elephant.*

*I'm not as tall as you.*

*France isn't as big as the USA.*
