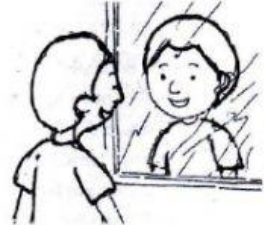

We use a reflexive pronoun to refer to the same person or thing in the same sentence.

	Pronouns	Reflexive Pronouns
<u>Singular</u>	I	myself
	You	yourself
	He	himself
	She	herself
	It	itself
<u>Plural</u>	You	yourselves
	We	ourselves
	They	themselves



Example: I smiled to myself. Jack and Tom are talking to themselves.
