

grew up reading classic science fiction such as
the works of A.C. Clarke and I. Asimov

followed his father in 1893 into the Indian Imperial Police
and was posted to Burma

was a sailor on a fishing schooner that went
to the shores of Japan to catch seals

was awarded the Pulitzer Prize and The Nobel Prize in Literature
for "The Old Man and the Sea"

the most frequent theme of the works is the conflict between
organized industrial society and the subconscious instincts of man

went to two schools where children were abused
(there boys got chocolate boxes to test candies)

was arrested and jailed for three years, in jail invented his pen name
invented the term «Jazz Age»

was British counterintelligence agent (his task is
to prevent Russia from getting out of the war at any cost)

left her husband twice and had love affairs
