The right person for the job?

Would you like to work in the video game industry? Here, Ganesh, the manager of a successful video game company, Creative Software, tells our reporter Ali about the people that his company employs.

Ali: Ganesh, thanks for talking to us. As you know, these days many people like playing video games and would like to work in the industry. Can you tell us something about the work that people do in your company?

Ganesh: Yes, of course. There are several different jobs that people can do, and the different jobs need different skills. For example, some people write the computer programs for the games. Some people test the new games. We have creative game designers who think of new games. (5)* _____. And of course, there are managers who look after the teams working on different games.

Ali: Well, those jobs all need different skills, I suppose? What abilities do you look for in your employees?

Ganesh: Well, we expect everyone coming into the company to have a good education. For example, to be a game developer, you should study computer programming in college. We want people who can write computer programs. But if

you've played a lot of games in your free time, and so have experience with games, that's also useful.

Ali: So where's a good place to start for people who are new to jobs in this area?

Ganesh: Well, many people start their careers as game testers. This is real work. It's not playing games all day. (6)* _____. The game tester looks for problems with a new game. It's a really important job. We don't want to sell games that don't work well.

Ali: So what type of person is suitable as a game tester?

Ganesh: We look for people who can focus for a long time, and who don't get bored quickly. You should also be able to write well. Writing reports on problems in games is quite difficult. (7)* _____. We want people who will work hard, and who like to work in a team. We want people who have a positive attitude.

Ali: And what about jobs higher up, then? What skills do you need?

Ganesh: After you have experience as a tester in our company, you can become a manager – what we call a “game producer.” Game producers plan the work schedules and support their teams. The game producer must make sure the team has everything they need. To be a good producer, you need to have good planning skills. You should be able to communicate well. It's also useful if you're good with numbers as you have to look after the money.

Ali: Well, thanks, Ganesh. That is very useful information for people interested in working with video games.

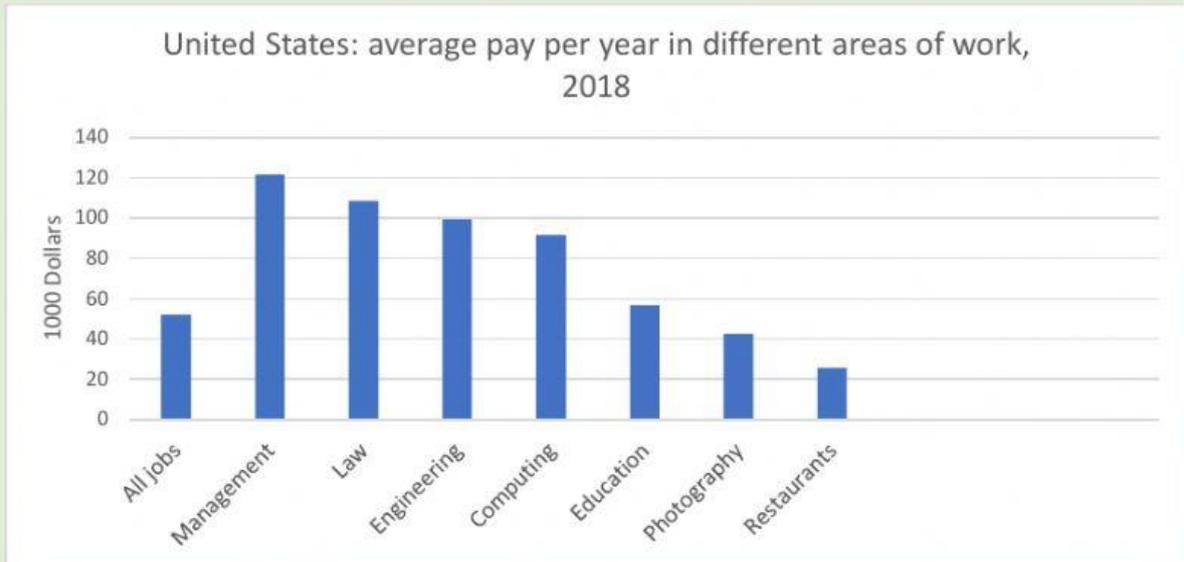
