Yorkshire pudding

Yorkshire pudding is a common English side dish. People make it from eggs, flour and milk. They serve it with roasted beef, potatoes, vegetables and *gravy* (a brown sauce). It is part of a traditional Sunday lunch.

Devon cream tea

Devon cream tea is a light meal in the afternoon at about 4 p.m. A cream tea includes *scones* and a pot of tea. A *scone* is a special type of bread made from flour, butter, sugar and milk with a few raisins in it. People serve scones warm and you cut them in half, then add cream or strawberry jam to them.

Cornish pasty

This is a pie with meat, potatoes, onions and carrots inside. You add a little salt and pepper to it and then bake it in the oven for 30 minutes. You can enjoy Cornish pasty with sauce.
