PAST SIMPLE	PAST CONTINUOUS
FORM: I/ you /he/ she / we / they/ work <u>ed</u> * (regular verbs) went (irregular verbs) I/you/he/she/we/they didn't work didn't go Did I/you/he/she/we/they work/go ?	FORM: Subject + was/were + ---ing I / he / she / it was going home We / you / they were going home I / he / she / it wasn't working We / you / they weren't working Where was I/ he / she / it going ? Where were you / we / they going ?
