When
S+Verb 2

When it started to rain, I was waiting for the train home.

Past Progressive

When another action happens in the middle of another action that was happening in the past

S+was/were+Verb-ing
While
S+was/were+Verb-ing

I was swimming while my sister was playing slide.

While they were chatting, I was walking away.
