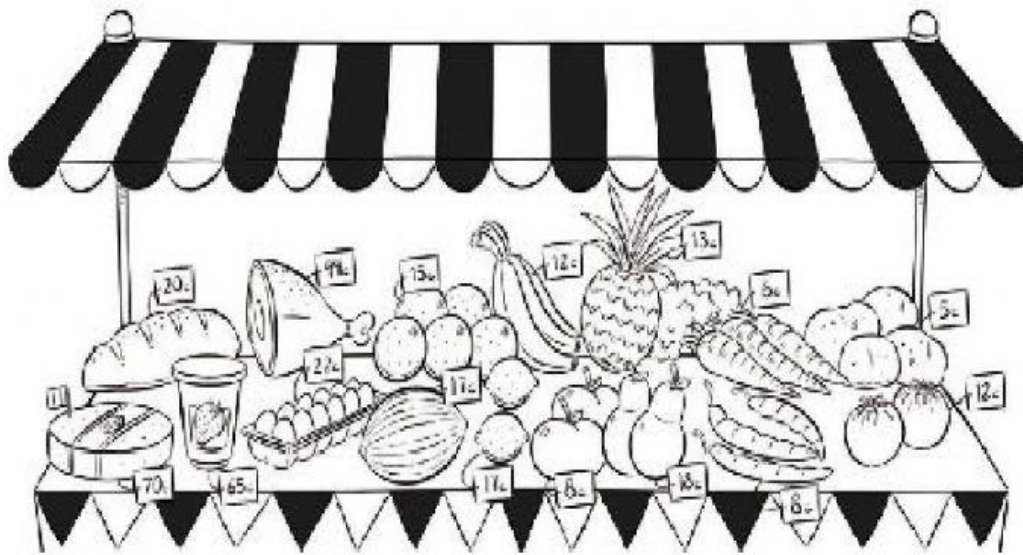

A + noun starting with a consonant

For example: A biscuit

An + noun starting with a vowel

For example: An apple

We use SOME with UNCOUNTABLES in SINGULAR (rice, milk, water, sugar, bread...)

For example: Some water

We use SOME with COUNTABLES in PLURAL.

For example: Some bananas
