

# PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE OR PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS?

TIP: "How long" makes reference to time. Therefore, it's very likely to have it associated with the Present Perfect Continuous. For example: how long have you been watching The Simpsons?

1. I \_\_\_\_\_ (do) this math exercise for an hour! I'm exhausted! 😞
2. My friends \_\_\_\_\_ (learn) how to drive. I'm so proud of them!
3. I think Lucy \_\_\_\_\_ (meet) Natsu in Fiore.
4. How long \_\_\_\_\_ (you/wait) for me? I'm very sorry I'm so late.
5. I \_\_\_\_\_ (visit) Rome. It's a very beautiful place.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ (you/study) for the exam?
7. I \_\_\_\_\_ (study) for the exam for four weeks! I want to pass it and have a good mark 😊.
8. We \_\_\_\_\_ (see) each other through a video call. He's very handsome.
9. We \_\_\_\_\_ (date) for three years.
10. I \_\_\_\_\_ (leave) my cell phone at home 😞.
