Mr Chiam bought 486 fishes and put them into fish tanks. Each fish tank held 9 fishes. How many fish tanks did Mr Chiam use?

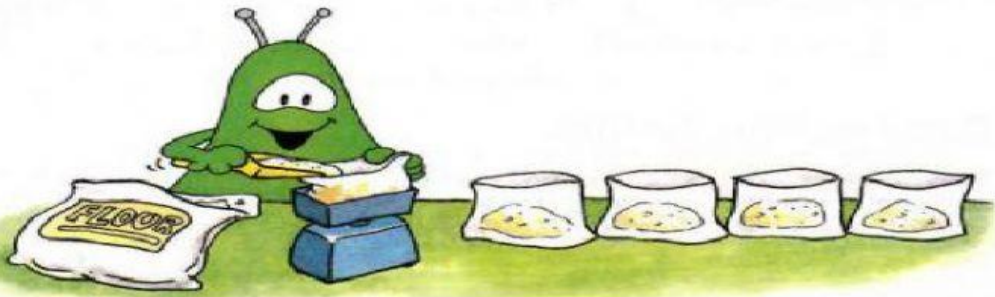
