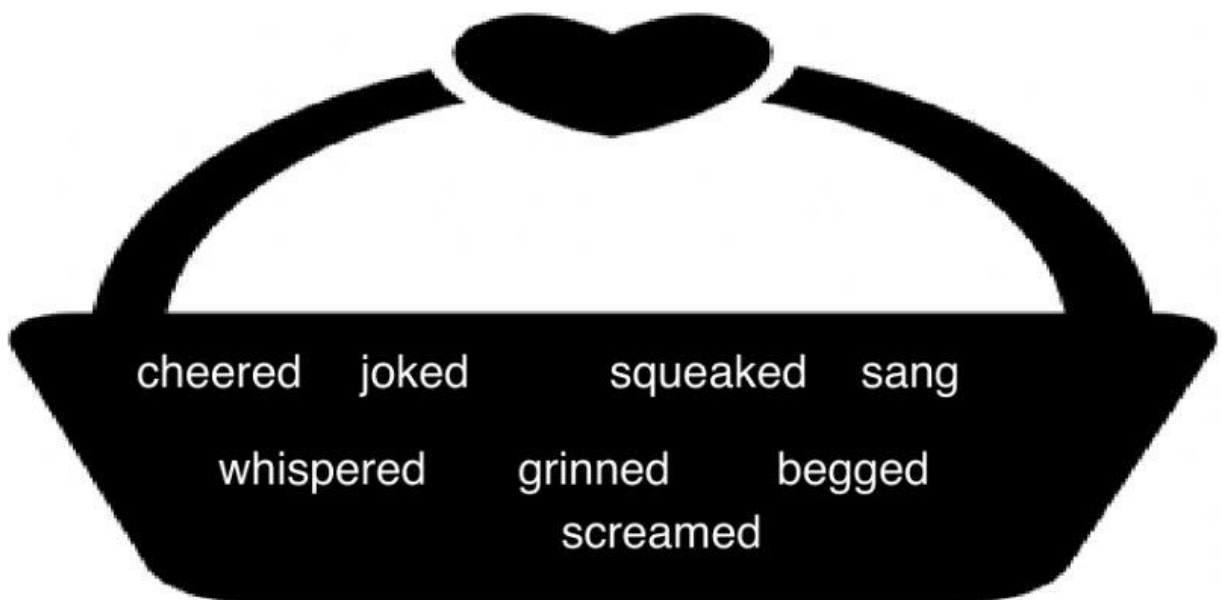
**SPEECH TAGS
