PIANO

The piano is one of the most popular musical instruments in our culture. The piano has strings, but you can't see them on every piano and it isn't considered a string instrument. It's actually considered a percussion instrument because each key on the keyboard triggers a hammer inside the piano that strikes a metal string, like a drum.

The piano was invented by Bartolomeo Cristofori in Italy in the early 1700s. It was originally called the "pianoforte." The words "piano" and "forte" mean "quiet" and "loud" respectively. When musicians play the piano, they play quietly by striking the keys softly, or loudly by striking them hard. This was one of the most appealing features of the piano when it was first introduced.
