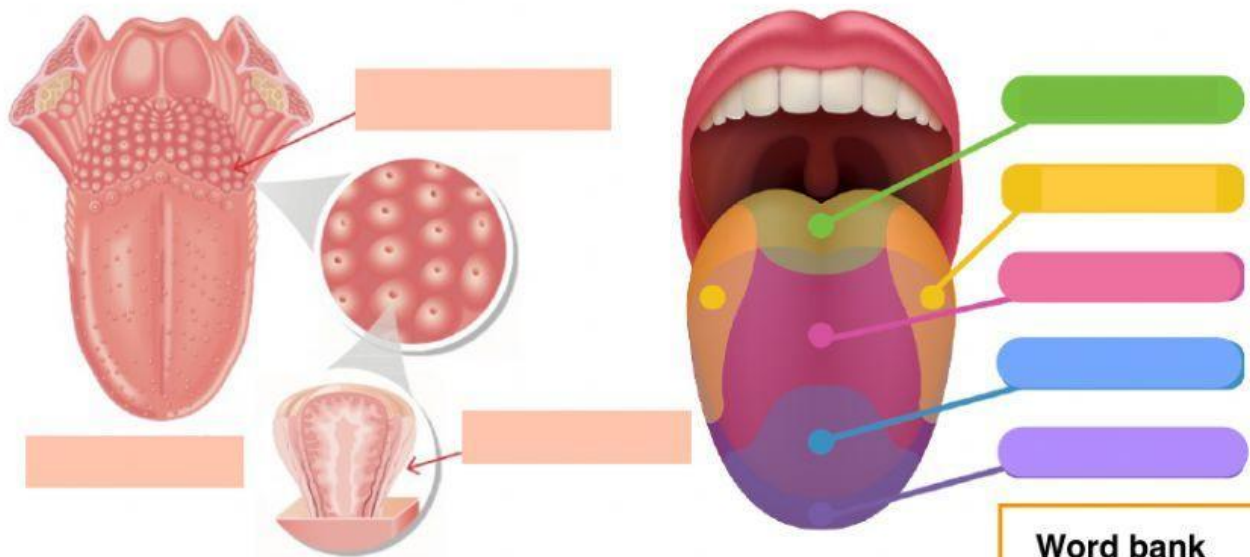

- Chemicals in the food we eat mix with saliva
- The taste buds detect chemicals in the food we eat.
