

Para señalar un objeto que está lejos usamos **THAT** o **THOSE**, **THAT** para uno y **THOSE** para muchos.

THIS/THAT/THESE/THOSE






Plural son aquellos objetos que son más de uno, en inglés al igual que en español a los plurales les aumentamos la "S"


