Below you will find some sentences that are used to give more extensive indications, you will have to find the relevant meaning of these sentences and thus match them

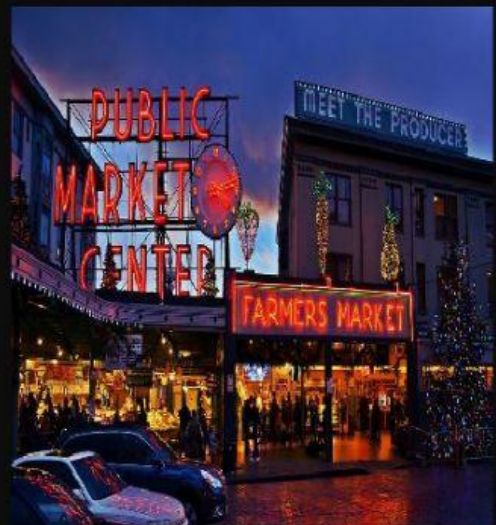
example: if two boxes match, you must write in both, join followed by the number of the box in which the second row is located for example the first one matches with the 6 definition, therefore I will write in both join6

|--------------------------------|-------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| To hang a left or right        | To turn at the next street on the left or right                                                                         |
| To pull over                   | To go in the directions of a certain location                                                                           |
| To pull out                    | To leave a parking spot to enter a road                                                                                 |
| To head towards                | To get off of the road you are on and stop your car on the side so you are not in the way on the moving cars behind you |
| Tu pull into                   | An object or a building that is very noticeable while driving                                                           |
| Landmark                       | Turn, so now you are driving or walking on the same street but in the opposite direction                                |
| To make a U turn               | To turn off the road you are currently on and go into the parking lot of a business or establishment                    |
| To take the firs left or right | To make a turn off of a road onto another                                                                               |
