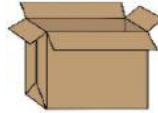
Plural Rules

boxes

If the noun ends in -y with a consonant before the -y, change the -y to -i and add -es

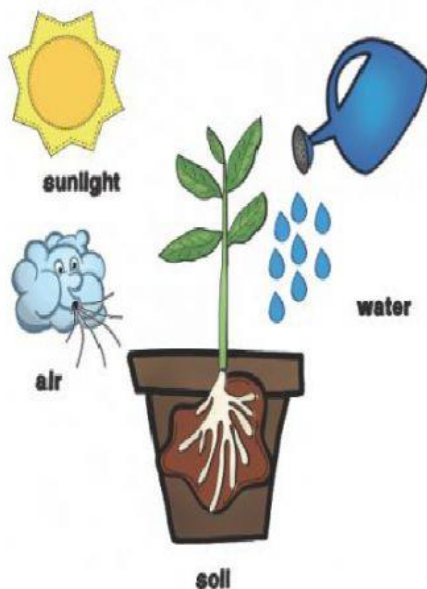

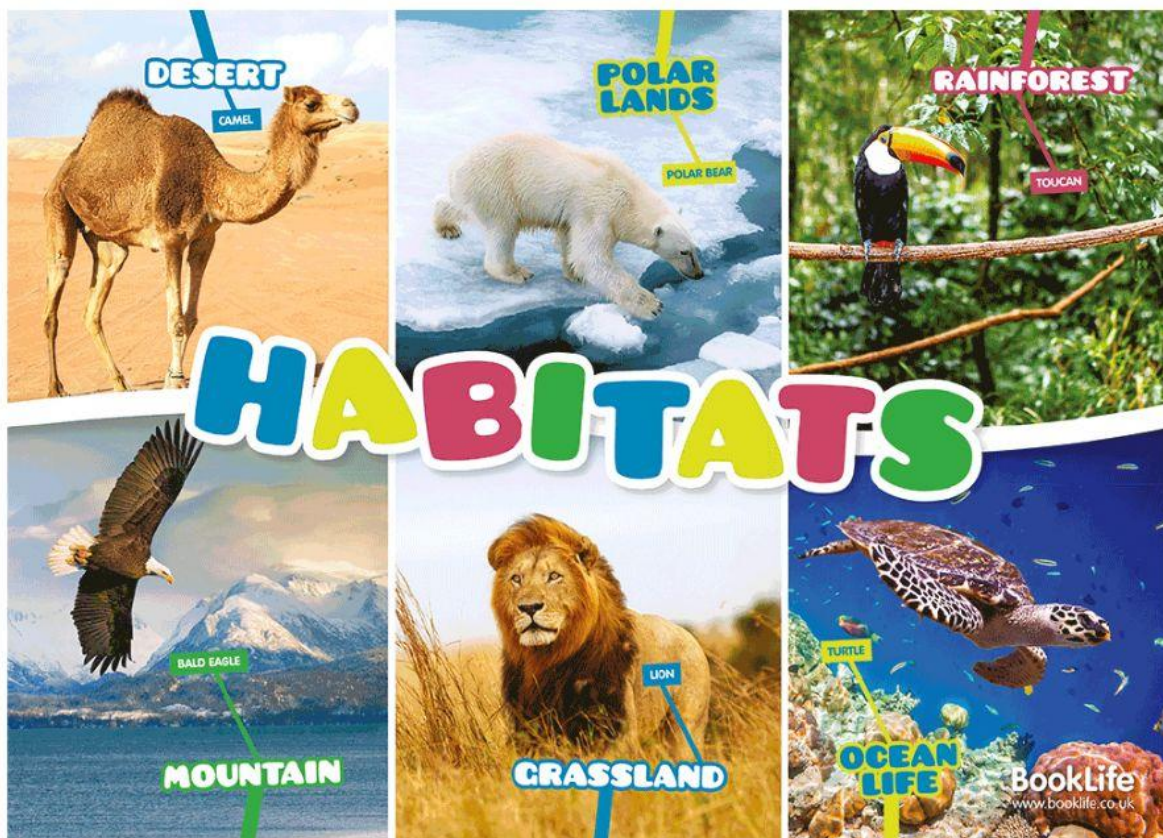

Plant Needs



Habitats

A habitat is a place where animals get food, water and shelter from. Some animals live in water only they are called “aquatic animals.” Some aquatic animals can live in habitats such as the sea like a fish, or oceans like a whale. Another type of habitat is a desert. A desert is a dry place with little to no water. Some animals that can survive in this habitat are camels and rattlesnakes. Some plants such as a cactus can live there also.

The third day (3rd)- dry land, seas, plants and trees were created

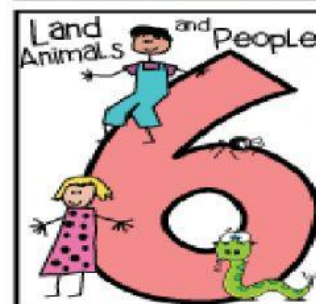
The fourth day (4th)- the sun, moon and stars were created

Living and non- living things
