
LO: To write a continuation of a story

- ✓ Write in the first person (I, me) in role as one of the band members.
- ✓ Write in the past tense you are telling the reader about something that has already happened.
- ✓ Add in some dialogue, using inverted commas.
- ✓ Don't make the plot too complicated!
- ✓ Use one or more of the features of Kay Umansky's style such as comical images, extra information in brackets, or made up adjectives like 'trollish'.

Remember you can use:

- adverbs they help us to describe how or when something happens (e.g. loudly, badly, later, earlier)
- adjectives they help us to describe someone or something (e.g. huge, hairy, kind, rude)
- exclamation marks they help us to show feelings like shock, horror, amazement and pleasure. Don't use too many though.
