- ✓ Write in the **first person** (I, me) in role as one of the band members.
- ✓ Write in the **past tense** – you are telling the reader about something that has already happened.
- ✓ Add in some **dialogue**, using inverted commas.
- ✓ Don't make the plot too complicated!
- ✓ Use one or more of the features of Kay Umansky's style such as comical images, extra information in brackets, or made up adjectives like 'trollish'.

**Remember you can use:**

- adverbs – they help us to describe how or when something happens (e.g. *loudly, badly, later, earlier*)
- adjectives – they help us to describe someone or something (e.g. *huge, hairy, kind, rude*)
- exclamation marks – they help us to show feelings like shock, horror, amazement and pleasure. Don't use too many though.
