


REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

Reflexive pronouns show that the action of the verb returns to the doer.

Reflexive pronouns are 'myself', 'yourself', 'himself', 'herself', 'itself', 'yourselves', 'themselves' and 'ourselves'.

Myself', 'yourself', 'himself', 'herself', 'yourselves', 'themselves' and 'ourselves' are used for **people**.

4 'Itself' and 'themselves' are used for animals.



I cooked the food myself.

He can do headstands by himself.

She can button her shirt by herself.

You must clean up the mess yourselves.

They can bathe the dog by themselves.

We are enjoying ourselves at the party.

Be careful! Don't cut yourself.

The dog is eating by itself.
