Stars are celestial bodies that emit their **own** light. For this reason, **they can illuminate other celestial bodies**.

Stars are very **large** but they appear very small to us.

Stars are very **far away** from the Earth.

Stars form groups called **galaxies**. **Some** groups **of stars form figures**. We call them **constellations**. We can see some of these **constellations** at night.
