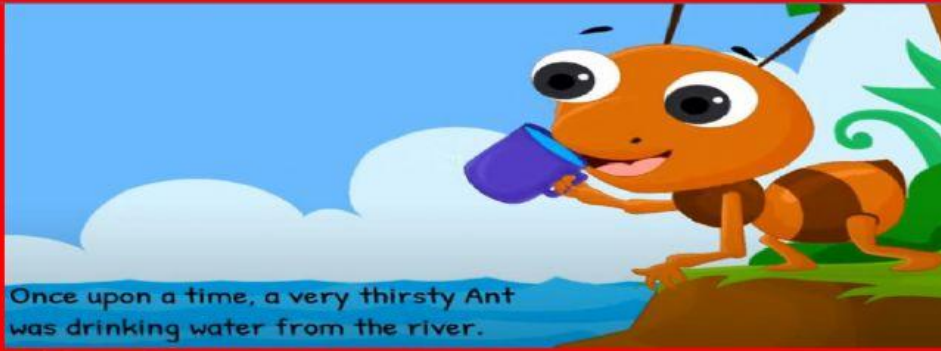

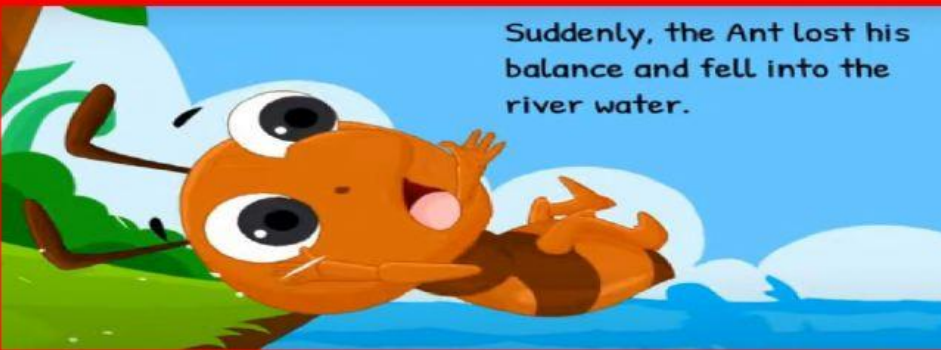

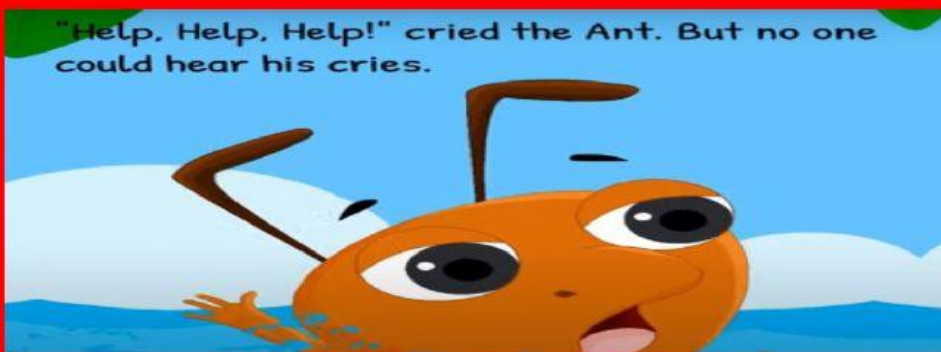


Suddenly-de pronto
