

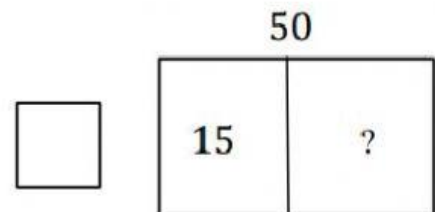
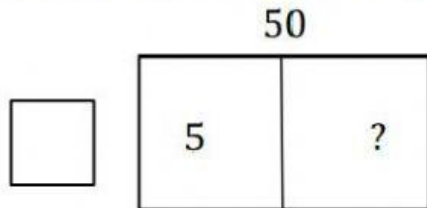
Subtraction Problems
