

# Present Continuous: Affirmative

	To be	verb+ing
 I	am	working
 You	are	playing
 He	is	jumping
 She	is	running
 It	is	going
 We	are	eating
 They	are	living

## Important Spelling Rules

- If the verb ends in vowel consonant DOUBLE the last letter run → running
- If the verb ends in consonant-e take off the -e and add -ing live → living
