As you are dealing with teenagers, you need to keep yourself in their situation and then think about it.

If parents feel that their children are disrespecting, they then tell that if their children want respect, they need to give it to other people too. This is a lifetime lesson which they need to learn as it is not limited to their home but also when they go out and work in any organization.

Children must understand their limitations. If they go beyond that, it will be difficult for them. It is the duty of the parents that they make their kids understand their limitation and define a boundary for them. This is done for the benefit of the children so that they know what is right and what is wrong for them.
