- She spent a long time looking at it.

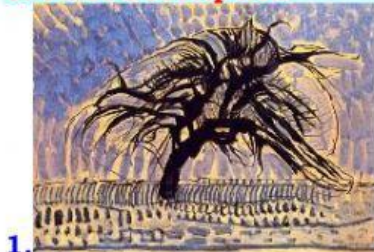
5. What suggestion does Carol make to David at the end of their conversation?
