

GRAMMAR: *I like doing versus I like to do* GRAMÁTICA: *I like doing contra I like to do*

Usamos LIKE para decir lo que nos gusta.

Cuando queremos expresar nuestros hobbies o intereses por algo, es decir, dar una idea general sobre lo que realmente no hace felices o disfrutamos hacer, usamos la forma **"like doing"**. Por ejemplo:

- I **like** playing football.
- You **like** cooking nice cakes.
- She **likes** painting pictures.

Cuando queremos decir simplemente lo que nos gusta y que hacemos de vez en cuando porque es un hábito, una elección del momento o preferencia, usamos la forma **"like to do"**. Por ejemplo:

- I **like to brush** my teeth three times a day.
- He **likes to clean** his house once a week.
- We **like to eat** sweets.
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Para preguntar si a alguien le gusta hacer algo:

Do you like "doing"? Yes, I do. / No, I don't

Por ejemplo:

- Do you like collecting stickers? Yes, I do.
- Does he like shopping? No, he doesn't.
