Superlatives with **-est** and **most**

I'm	the	shortest	student	in my class.
He's		tallest	actor	on TV.
She's		funniest	person	I know.
It's		most popular	food	on the menu.
They're		most famous	football players	in the world.

One syllable: *short* → **the shortest** *tall* → **the tallest**

Two syllables ending in y: *funny* → **the funniest**

Two or more syllables: *famous* → **the most famous** *popular* → **the most popular**
