

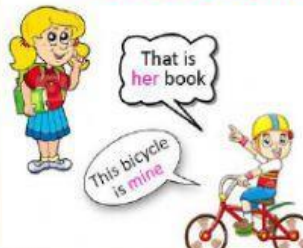

Remember

Possessive Pronouns



a pronoun indicating possession, for example mine, yours, hers, theirs.

- This pen is **my** pen, not **your** pen.
- This pen is **mine**, not **yours**.



MINE	• This is my laptop. It's mine .
YOURS	• These glasses are mine, not yours .
HIS	• This is my brother 's book. It's his .
HERS	• He offered to swap his camera for hers .
OURS	• I'll show you to your room. Ours is next door.
THEIRS	• The ship is theirs .
